TSK History Gallery

The History Gallery was renovated and reopened in 2012. The six houses of TSK in those years are represented by the six colours in the interfacing stripes across the wall. Priceless exhibits are proudly presented, like the past photos featured along the "History Corridor" and the trophies arrayed at the "Arch of Triumph". Visitors were mostly impressed by the tree ring symbol that denotes the Chinese saying, "It takes a decade to grow a tree and a century to educate a person".


肇堅歷史一宣揚承先啟後

The Chapel

As a well-facilitated Christian secondary school, a chapel was installed shortly after TSK was founded. The chapel has been relocated a few times for the school's developments at different milestones. A permanent venue that is deemed most suitable for nurturing students' spiritual growth was chosen in 2012 as the school celebrated its memorable Golden Jubilee. The chapel was dedicated by the Most Reverend Paul Kwong on 11th September, 2013.



The chapel provides not only a venue for the Christian Fellowship, but also a spiritual haven that allows teachers and students quiet time of meditation, devotion and prayers, away from the hustle and bustle of everyday life.



The chapel features six stained glass windows that narrate six events in the life of Jesus, including "Let the Little Ones Come to Me", "Five Loaves and Two Fish", "Jesus Heals a Lame", "Jesus Changes Water to Wine", "Love Your Neighbour as Yourself" and "The Transfiguration". The six pieces of stained glass paintings and other decorations in the chapel create a sacred and peaceful space that welcomes every student, alumnus, parent or teacher who enters the chapel to reach God and to have their strength renewed.

Sports Complex

The construction of the TSK Sports Complex started in 1984 and was completed in 1986. The old complex featured an all-season heated swimming pool (G/F), two standard squash courts (1/F) and a dancing room. The gymnasium on 3/F provided a venue for regular PE lessons and sports team practice after school.



As the facilities had aged and been damaged after 28 years of use, the school started a fundraising campaign for a comprehensive maintenance and renovation project. The 8-month project was completed in 2015. Facilities, including the car park on G/F, the indoor swimming pool, the squash courts and the gymnasium, now all display a fresh new look. The dancing room on 1/F has been refurnished and is now a well-facilitated fitness center. The school was careful with the renovation materials we chose so that students can enjoy best-quality sports facilities that help keep both their body and mind strong.





Recital Studio

The TSK Recital Studio was completed in 2021 with the support of the Quality Education Fund (QEF). This dedicated space was meticulously designed to accommodate a wide range of activities, from rehearsals and performances to instrumental classes and audio recordings.

The studio is equipped with recording facilities that enable our students to produce high-quality audio recordings. Members of the TSK Recital Studio Production Team receive training from experienced sound professionals to ensure the quality of our productions. They provide regular support at various school events and guest performances. The team's expertise was showcased in several notable projects, such as:

- Recordings of our school choir and orchestra during the Annual Speech Day
- Post-production of the live recording of our Diamond Jubilee Musical "Fame Jr."
- Recordings of a song dedicated to TSK's 60th birthday, written by a recent graduate Fan Chit Hei, and a Waltz by Chopin, performed by Yik Kai Yan (F.6D, 2023-2024)
- Recordings featuring Mozart's Missae Breves and the choral works of renowned composer Richard Tsang, performed by the Chinese University of Hong Kong Chorus
- Recordings of the 20th Anniversary theme song for the "Chief Executive's Award for Teaching Excellence Teachers' Association"



By providing students with hands-on experiences in audio production, the TSK Recital Studio aims to nurture their skills and appreciation for the art of sound engineering.

Science Education

At TSK, we are committed to providing comprehensive science education that prepares our students for the modern world. Our curriculum is designed to foster a deep understanding of how different science disciplines are interconnected. Students' mastery and application of scientific concepts are evaluated through a diverse range of assessment methods.

Beyond the classroom, students are encouraged to apply their knowledge in real-world contexts and carry out student-led projects. Our students have excelled in multiple prestigious science competitions, earning accolades that reflect their exceptional scientific prowess. To further enrich their experiences, engaging activities that foster a deeper appreciation for the natural world were organised. These activities inspire students to become responsible stewards of the environment.





We take great pride in our effort to cultivate scientific mindsets and empower our students to excel as innovators and problem-solvers. We are thrilled to highlight the achievement of Kwok Ching Yeung, one of our outstanding graduates, who represented Hong Kong at the International Physics Olympiad 2023 in Tokyo and received a silver medal. Kwok Ching Yeung is currently studying at the University of Cambridge. His devoted pursuit for scientific excellence is a great inspiration for our students.

STEM Education

STEM Education at TSK continues to evolve to prepare our students for a technologically advanced world. This year, we introduced "The Big Rescue", an Inter-house competition utilizing Arduino technology. The STEM Society enhanced its programs by introducing workshops on Robomaster and C++, connecting theoretical knowledge with practical application. Our students showcased their skills in the Robot Arm Competition and won the third prize. Junior form Computer Literarcy students gained crucial skills for the digital age through exploring Virtual Reality, microbit coding, IoT, and app development. The enhancement programmes underscore our commitment to fostering a learning environment where students are not just consumers of technology but also creators and innovators ready for future challenges. Our students are all team players equipped with technical expertise that allows them to tackle future challenges with confidence and resilience.





Geography Education

Geography activities under different themes

Dynamic Earth of Hong Kong

Students visited Stephen Hui Geological Museum at the University of Hong Kong, where they explored the collections of minerals, rock specimens and fossils.

We also took part in the Geopark Schools Programme organized by the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department. Students attended a talk entitled 'Formation and Evolution of Landscapes in Hong Kong'. They also joined a guided tour to Yim Tin Tsai in Sai Kung, where they explored the saltpans, natural ecology and cultural heritage. A field excursion to Tung Ping Chau was arranged for students to learn about the rocks and geological structures, as well as countryside and rural conservation.







Food problem

Students visited the K-farm in Kennedy Town. They understood the latest development of food production technology conducive to food safety, such as aquaponics and hydroponics.



Sustainable City

Students visited the City Gallery to learn about the planning and development of urban areas in Hong Kong.

F.4 to F.5 students also joined the 'UrbanPlan Workshop' organized by the Urban Land Institute to translate concepts into practice. Participants planned and designed a livable district for the needs of different stakeholders with LEGO blocks.

Coastal studies

F.4 students took part in a field study course entitled 'Exploring the Coast in Cheung Chau' organized by the Chan Chun Ha Field Study Centre. In this course, students practised field enquiry skills while exercising critical thinking.



Study Tour for Exploring Geography in Taiwan

It was a signature activity organized for F.4-5 geography students from 2 July to 6 July 2024. During the tour, the students explored different places in Taipei and Taichung. Below is the sharing from one of the participants.



Incredible Trip to Taiwan

In early July, we embarked on a journey to Taiwan. The beautiful green landscape was certainly gorgeous! The steam vent and hot springs at Yangmingshan, the oddly shaped rock formation at Yehliu, the colourful lychee orchard, the sustainable industrial development of Central Taiwan Science Park, and the lively night markets absolutely blew me. It was a truly magnificent experience for me to witness all those amazing attractions. Not only did I learn the human and physical geography of Taiwan, but also shared valuable memories with my friends.

Learning of National Geography

The learning of our nation's geography is integrated into the school curriculum within and beyond the classroom. On 16 April 2024, an Inter-class National Geography Quiz Competition was organized for F.1-3 students. The quiz included fun-filled online activities designed by senior form students. They helped improve students' understanding of our nation's geography and enhanced their sense of national identity.

Using Geographic Information System

The Geographic Information System (GIS) is an essential tool to display spatial data in geography. On 17 January 2024, students visited the Geospatial Lab for a workshop to gain hands-on experience using GIS. Some Form 4-5 students received extra training for competitions which required students to present spatial data using ArcGIS StoryMaps.

Education for Sustainable Development

In the academic year 2023-24, students were arranged to participate in a wide range of environmental educational activities and programmes.



Student Environmental Protection Ambassador (SEPA) Scheme and Green Prefect Programme organized by the Environmental Campaign Committee, Environment and Ecology Bureau and Education Bureau

Under the SEPA scheme, students joined different environmental training activities, including online seminars, STEM workshop, field visits, and community promotion and education activities. Most of the F.3 to F.5 SEPAs act as Green Prefects to monitor students' green habits on campus and organise various environmental activities to promote carbon neutrality and the United Nations Sustainable

Development Goals.





'Seahorse Rangers' launched by Ocean Park

Thirty F.3 to F.5 students participated in the programme entitled 'Seahorse Rangers' from Nov 2023 to Jul 2024. They completed various self-directed learning tasks to achieve their designated conservation goals. On 10 Jan 2024, ten of them attended the Animal Faeces Papermaking Lesson and a seminar on 'Eat Local' at the inauguration ceremony. In addition, they took the lead in all three flagship activities, including SGREEN Recycle at School, Low Carbon PLS Day, and City Nature Challenge 2024. Finally, our school was recognized as an Outstanding School by the Ocean Park Conservation Alliance and was given the Ocean Park Conservation Alliance Champion School – Distinguished Community Service Award.





'Happy Green Campaign' organized by HK Electric

Twenty-three F.2 to F.5 students visited the Smart Power Gallery in Sheung Wan, where they participated in fun-filled activities and a STEAM workshop themed on decarbonisation and smart city. Additionally, three F.3 Student Environmental Protection Ambassadors were nominated Happy Green Ambassadors to receive training and participate in life planning experiences from Oct 2023 to May 2024. They also shared about green lunch, energy conservation and eco-fashion with their schoolmates. One of the participants was awarded the Outstanding Happy Green Ambassador.

中華文化節

中華文化節於2024年2月順利進行,內容豐富多彩。在「小小中醫師」中,同學在中醫師的指導下製作紫雲膏,非華語同學亦樂在其中;在「中華文化問答比賽」中,同學除有機會挑戰對中華文化的認識外,還可體驗投壺的樂趣;在「《長安三萬里》電影欣賞」中,同學從高適的視角認識著名詩人李白、杜甫等,為昔日大唐的人文風景所震懾。



Visiting Hong Kong Cemetery

The History Department organized a guided tour to Hong Kong Cemetery, the oldest Western cemetery in the city, established in 1845. Students first visited the chapel within the cemetery grounds. The chapel is considered the oldest Western style building in Hong Kong. Afterwards, students visited the tombs of several notable historical figures, including Yeung Ku-Wan and Sir Robert Hotung. Both of them made profound impact on the history of Hong Kong. Overall, the field trip offered a unique experience that allowed students to have a better understanding of our local history.

Visiting Mount Davis Fortress

Eighteen F.3 to F.5 students participated in a field trip organized by the History Society to visit Mount Davis. They visited the Mount Davis Fortress, which was constructed in 1911. Through examining the Grade 2 historic building, students experienced the Battle of Hong Kong in 1941 through observing the remains of artillery batteries, observation posts, shelters, and the soldier's drilling ground. Apart from war ruins, students also enjoyed the scenic views of Lamma Island and the Kap Shui Mun Strait. The natural and cultural landscapes along the heritage trail were impressive.







English Carnival

This year's English Carnival was a collaborative effort between the English Department and the Education for Sustainable Development Committee on the theme of United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

There were a total of 18 creative and educational game booths set up by F.3 to F.5 students, the English Society and the Education for Sustainable Development Committee. The carnival not only served as a platform for all participants to immerse themselves in an interactive English environment, but it also helped them develop an increased environmental awareness to adopt a more eco-friendly lifestyle, which is one of the core values enshrined here at TSK.

Inter-house Quiz

The long-anticipated Inter-house Quiz was without a doubt a thrilling event that captivated all of us and showcased the true essence of companionship and competitive spirit.



The quiz itself was a roller coaster of emotions with the function cards adding an extra layer of excitement. Intensity was high as every group fought for victory with their eyes gleaming with determination. The competitors, true warriors of knowledge and sportsmanship, gave it their all, dazzling the audience with brilliance and unwavering support for each other.

The game of Charades brought a dose of laughter. The 17th AFS Intercultural Fair

Nine F.3 students participated in the Intercultural Fair at ELCHK Lutheran Secondary School. Shortly after a briefing session, participants engaged actively in three sessions of classroom activities, concluded by exhibitions that introduced different cultures. Participants enjoyed a wonderful opportunity to learn about different cultures through interacting with foreign students.









Japan STEM and Historical Cultural Study Tour

The study tour, held from 27 to 31 December 2023, was a collaboration among three departments: Chinese History, History and Science. Thirty students had the opportunity to visit three cities (Hiroshima, Fukuoka, Japanese Shimonoseki) to learn about the culture and history of Japan, as well as its developments in STEM. To experience the Japanese culture, our students tried rice spoon calligraphy on Miyajima and visited several shrines including Itsukushima Shinto Shrine and Dazaifu Monzen Machi. They also visited Karato Market, which is famous for its local puffer fish sashimi. In order to learn more about the STEM and technological development of Japan, students visited Fukuoka City Science Museum and Mazda Museum to find out more about the car manufacturing process. In addition, students also went to Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum and Genbaku Dome to learn more about the devastating atomic bombing of Hiroshima. Last but not least, students visited the Sino-Japanese Peace Memorial Hall, where the Treaty of Shimonoseki was signed. Despite the language barrier, students found this tour fruitful and educational.

Leadership Training

TSK values the importance of all-round education, and leadership training is one of the most emphasized aspects of school life. The prefect camp and leadership training camp are some of the major activities arranged throughout the year to foster students' leadership qualities. A spirit of cooperation is fostered as students sharpen their skills in teams. The activities also further develop their problem-solving abilities.



During this year's prefect camp at Y.W.C.A. Sydney Leong Holiday Lodge on Lantau Island, the prefects were given diverse tasks they had to complete in groups within the time limits. The student leaders had to communicate effectively, think quickly and exercise numerous generic skills that are essential for effective leadership. Debriefing sessions were held at the end of each task to let participants share what they had learned. Advice for improvement and words of encouragement from the Y.W.C.A. mentors consolidated the entire learning experience.

Similar activities boost students' potential to be outstanding leaders. They provide experiences that students could refer to when they carry out important duties in real life. Our ultimate goal is to cultivate a future generation of healthy and confident young leaders who serve and contribute to society responsibly and with good leadership skills.

Careers and Life Planning

Careers and life-planning at TSK aims at helping students understand themselves and providing knowledge and experience that allow them to make sensible and well-informed choices. Some highlights for the academic year include:

Support for F.3 students – workshops, sharing and bookfair

Intentional effort was made to help F.3 students get prepared for our restructured senior secondary subject selection mechanism, which aims to allow students to have a wider choice,

more flexibility and higher satisfaction.

Deploying assessment tools suitable for the age group, social workers from St. James' Settlement conducted a class-based 1.5-hr session in which students learnt about their personalities and working styles in January.







Borrowing the idea of university info days, booths were set up during lunch time. Representatives from each elective subject (including both senior form students and graduates) displayed their learning materials so that F.3 students could look at the authentic texts and ask questions in a casual and welcoming setting.

In May, F.5 students shared about their experience during a 35-minute Form Teacher Period: how they made their choices

in F.3 and how they have been handling the elective subjects. Shortly before the deadline to submit their subject selection choices, our school social workers conducted mini-workshops in class to consolidate the information and advice students had been receiving in the school year.

iGESS - Intergenerational engagement in collaboration with HKBU and PolyU

A group of F.4 to F.5 students took part in the programme which aimed at enhancing inter-generational co-learning activities. Customized for our school's initiatives to get students involved in community service, the last session of the six-hour programme was a visit to an elderly day care centre. Older adults and students from the two universities worked in teams with TSK students to explore issues such as ageing and to design programmes suitable for the elderly they planned to visit.




Talent Show
